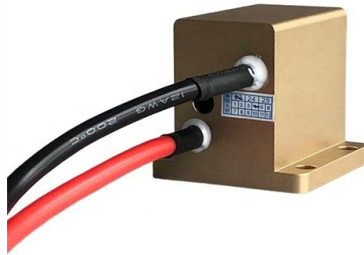


Aerial Optical Cable Laying Procedure

Methods of Aerial Cable Laying

Fixed-Pulley Traction Method: The cable is pulled along a pre-installed cable tray using pulleys. Large pulleys are fixed at the start and end poles, while small guide pulleys are placed every 10–20 meters. The cable is gradually released either manually or mechanically, ensuring tension is controlled to prevent fiber damage. Long cable runs may be laid in two stages, forming an "8" shape on the ground for the first half before completing the second half.

Cable Tray Moving and Releasing Method: The cable is deployed from a moving tray or reel along the aerial route. This method is suitable for routes with minimal obstacles and allows continuous cable deployment with reduced handling.

Lashed Installation: A fiber cable is lashed to a pre-installed messenger strand, often used for adding fibers to existing aerial networks. Proper spacing and tensioning are critical to avoid damage during installation.

Cable Types

ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting): Non-conductive, supports its own weight, suitable near power lines, and requires careful attention to tension and creep behavior.

Figure-8 / Self-Supporting: Integrated steel messenger in a figure-eight cross-section, allowing single-pass installation over specific span lengths.

Catenary / Lashed: Loose-tube cable helically lashed to a support line, flexible for network expansions.

Planning and Preparation

Survey the route and inspect existing poles or structures. Obtain permits and coordinate with local authorities. Determine splice points and slack storage locations. Select appropriate cable type and hardware based on environmental conditions, span length, and mechanical stress.
