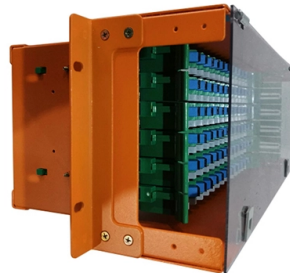


Cable Tray Welding Methods
