The DIN Standard 4102 part 12 defines the requirements and testing method for fire resistance of electric cable support systems required to maintain its integrity. The standard, limited to 1KV, specifies 3 categories of functional maintenance as follows: E30, E60 and E90. Fire protection technology plays a central role in ensuring the safety of people and buildings. In the event of a fire, it is necessary to maintain the functionality of certain electrical installations, such as. The UL 1257 testing standard evaluates the performance of cable tray and conduit assemblies in a fire environment by subjecting them to various temperature conditions. This includes: Filling the assembly with combustible material to simulate real-world exposure; however, as an alternative DIN. Until the European standard is published, VERGOKAN uses, the DIN 4102-12 Standard to test and certify the preservation of functionality of its installations.
