Fiber optic cold connection, also known as mechanical splicing, is a widely used method of connecting optical fibers in a network. This allows both fibre ends to become soft enough to merge into a single fibre-optic path. After cooling, the Splice is reinforced with a heat-shrink sleeve to restore the fibre's. Active connection utilizes various fiber optic connectors (plugs and sockets) to connect site-to-site or site-to-cable. This method is flexible, simple, convenient, and reliable, commonly used in building computer network cabling. The typical attenuation is 1dB per connection. Unlike fiber splicing, which is permanent, connectors allow for easy connection and disconnection of cables, making them ideal for maintenance and flexibility in.
