3. Solid-Bottom Cable Tray Solid-bottom trays provide a fully enclosed base, offering maximum protection for sensitive network cables such as fiber optics. They prevent dust, debris, and accidental contact, making them suitable for environments where cable integrity is critical. However, they have limited ventilation, so heat dissipation must be considered.
4. Wire Mesh (Basket) Cable Tray Wire mesh or basket trays are lightweight, open-grid structures made from welded steel wires. They are ideal for network installations where frequent changes or additions are expected, such as data centers or IT rooms. The open design allows easy cable routing, supports multiple bends, and simplifies maintenance.

- Cable type and weight: Fiber optic cables may require solid-bottom trays, while copper network cables can use ladder or perforated trays.
