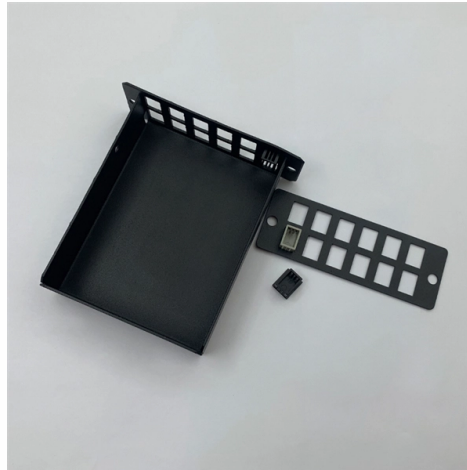


Data transmission is not working after fiber optic cable is plugged into the switch

Step 4: Test Signal Strength Use a power meter or Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) to measure the optical signal. Values outside the typical range (e.g., -15 dBm to -30 dBm) indicate a problem with the cable, transceiver, or the device at the other end. A "LOS" (Loss of Signal) LED on the transceiver also signals connectivity issues.

Step 5: Swap Components If the physical layer appears intact, swap the transceiver with a known-good unit and test the link. Similarly, try a different fiber patch cable to rule out cable defects.
