

Deep laying depth of direct-buried optical cables

Trench Preparation and Backfilling The trench bottom should be flat and free of debris such as stones or hard clods. If the soil is stony, a 10 cm layer of fine soil or sand should be laid as bedding. After laying the cable, a protective layer of 30 cm of fine soil or sand should be backfilled to prevent mechanical damage. Hard materials like gravel or bricks should not be mixed into this layer. For additional safety, a warning tape (bright orange, minimum 3 inches wide) can be buried approximately 12 inches (30 cm) above the cable to alert future excavators.

Cable Selection and Protection Armored fiber optic cables (e.g., GYTA53) are recommended for direct burial, as they provide protection against moisture, rodents, and soil pressure. In some cases, conduits (PVC or HDPE) are used for extra protection, especially under roads or in areas with high mechanical stress. When multiple cables are laid in the same trench, they should be placed separately and parallel, avoiding crossing or overlapping at the trench bottom. Stan...
