The International Electrotechnical Commission Technical Committee 86 (IEC TC 86) is an international standardization organization that prepares and decides on international standards in relation to products used for optical fiber telecommunication. These cables, composed of thin strands of glass or plastic, transmit data using pulses of light rather than electrical signals. This approach offers superior bandwidth, decreased signal loss, and minimal interference compared to.
