- Connection:** Organizing live, neutral, and protective earth conductors efficiently.
- Containment:** Protecting users from live parts and components from environmental stress.

Components Involved in Allocation A typical allocation scheme considers the following components:

- Main Switch/Isolator:** Controls the overall supply to the DB.
- Busbars:** Conduct electricity to multiple circuits; phase busbars distribute live power, while neutral and earth bars provide return paths and grounding.
- MCBs, RCCBs, RCBOs:** Protect individual circuits; allocation ensures circuits with higher loads or critical functions are assigned appropriately.
- SPD (Surge Protective Device):** Installed where risk assessment indicates potential surges.
- Circuit Labeling:** Each circuit is clearly identified with its area or appliance served, complying with standards like BS 7671 or IEC 61439.

- Load Balancing:** Distribute high-power circuits (e.g., HVAC, kitchen appliances) across different phases in three-phase systems to prevent overloading....
