Load and Number of Circuits: Choose breakers based on actual load and future expansion.

Protection Strategy: Decide between MCB, RCBO, RCCB, or MCCB depending on overcurrent and earth leakage requirements.

Enclosure Type: IP rating, material, and mounting method must match installation environment (indoor, outdoor, weatherproof).

Standards Compliance: Ensure breakers meet IEC, UL, CSA, or local codes.

Busbar and Wiring Compatibility: Check DIN rail space, neutral and earth bar arrangement,...
