The flat pieces are then bent and formed using hydraulic or CNC press brakes to create the box's sides, back, and top. Holes for circuit breakers, switches, cable entries, and mounting hardware are made with punching and drilling machines, ensuring exact alignment for component installation.

Assembly and Welding Depending on the design, parts of the shell are spot-welded or fastened together, with reinforcements added at stress points. For plastic enclosures, components are molded and assembled with precision. The assembly ensures structural integrity and proper fit for internal electrical components like busbars, terminals, and breakers.

Surface Finishing To protect against corrosion and environmental damage, shells undergo surface treatments such as phosphate coating, powder coating, or UV-resistant finishes. This step ensures the enclosure maintains its appearance and performance over time, even in harsh outdoor conditions.

Quality Control and Testing Finished shells are subjected to electrical safety tests, insulation resistance checks, grounding verification, and load tests. Ing...
