- Dedicated circuits:** High-power appliances like air conditioners, water heaters, or ovens should have their own breakers to prevent overloading.
- Load Calculation and Spare Capacity** Begin by calculating the total electrical load of all appliances, lighting, and devices. Add at least 30% spare capacity to accommodate future additions or renovations. This ensures the distribution box remains safe and functional as your electrical needs grow.
- Configuration Considerations** Residential setups usually require single-phase power with 6–24 circuits, including separate circuits for lighting, sockets, and major appliances. Commercial or industrial setups may require three-phase power and more complex configurations to handle higher loads and multiple equipment types. Busbars, neutral, and earth bars must be compatible with the selected switches to ensure proper distribution and grounding.
