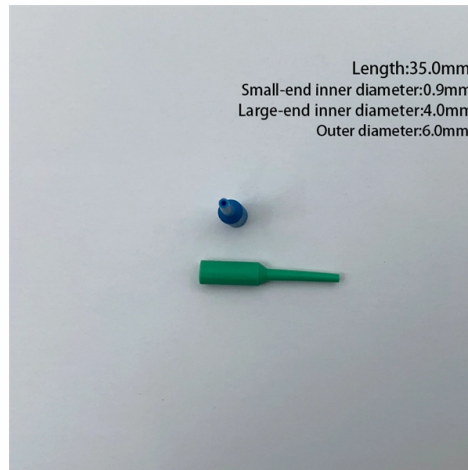


Do home fiber optic connections use switches

Step 3: Connect the ONT to Your Switch

Use a standard Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to your switch's uplink port. Power on the switch and ensure the link lights indicate a successful connection. If the switch is far from the ONT or in a separate building, use a fiber-to-Ethernet media converter at each end to maintain signal integrity and electrical isolation.

Step 4: Consider Fiber Type and Connectors

- Single-mode vs. Multi-mode:** Single-mode fiber (OS1/OS2) is ideal for long distances; multi-mode (OM3/OM4) works well for shorter runs inside a home.
- Connectors:** LC connectors with UPC polish are common for home networking; SC/APC connectors are often used in ISP installations. Avoid bending fiber beyond manufacturer recommendations to prevent signal loss or microfractures.

Step 5: Op...

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Choose an SFP module based on the fiber optic cabling that will be connected to the network switches. SFP transceiver modules almost always require two fiber optic cable strands.
