Placing an electrical distribution box directly over stair steps is prohibited, but installation on a stair landing may be allowed if code-required clearances and working space are maintained. NEC Compliance and Safety Considerations According to the National Electrical Code (NEC), overcurrent protective devices such as panelboards cannot be installed over the steps of a stairway (NEC 240.24(F)). This is to prevent hazards when accessing the panel and to ensure safe egress. However, a panelboard can be installed on a stair landing if the landing provides sufficient working space: a minimum of 2 feet 6 inches wide by 3 feet deep, with at least 6 feet 6 inches of headroom in front of the panel, and the panel door must swing open to 90 degrees.

Exit Enclosure Restrictions If the stairwell is part of an exit enclosure (required for egress), the NEC and NFPA 101 restrict the installation of electrical equipment and wiring to only what is essential for the stairway, such as emergency lighting, fire department communication systems, or ventilation equipment. Non-essential panels or conduits are generally not permitted in these areas, and local authorities having jurisdiction (AHJ) may enforce stricter rules.

Practical Considerations Headroom and access: Equipment under stairs may be limited due to headroom requirements, and the working space in front of the panel must remain unobstructed. Fire safety: Any wall penetrations for wiring must be properly fire-stopped, especially in fire-rated walls or partitions, to prevent the spread of fire. Existing installations: Panels installed under stairs before current code adoption may be grandfathered, but upgrades or new installations are typically not allowed in the same location.
