For pre-terminated cables, ensure connectors are clean before installation to prevent signal loss. Routing Techniques Maintain proper bend radius: Avoid sharp turns; follow manufacturer-specified minimum bend radii to prevent macrobends and microbends. Use figure-8 loops when coiling excess cable to prevent twisting. Pull by the strength member (e.g., aramid fibers) rather than the fiber itself to avoid breakage. Avoid mechanical stress: Do not place fiber under heavy copper bundles or use rigid supports that can crush the cable. Secure cables properly: Use soft Velcro ties or flexible low-voltage conduit instead of plastic zip ties, especially in high-traffic areas. Clamp vertical runs at intervals to support weight and prevent long-term tension damage. Safety and Compliance Follow industry standards such as ANSI/NECA/FOA-301, TIA/EIA-568, and NEC Article 770 for design, safety, and installation.
