Fiber Optic Components Cables and Connectors: Common fiber connectors include SC (Subscriber Connector) and LC (Lucent Connector), which provide secure, low-loss connections. SC connectors are square-shaped with push-pull coupling, while LC connectors are smaller and ideal for high-density environments. Transceivers: Small Form-factor Pluggable (SFP) modules convert electrical signals to optical signals and support speeds up to 10 Gbps or higher, depending on the module type. Interconnection Devices: SANs use switches, directors, or hubs to route data between servers and storage arrays. Switches are preferred for performance and scalability, while directors offer high port counts and fault tolerance for large data centers. Fiber Arrays For high-density or multi-channel connections, fiber arrays can be used. These are one- or two-dimensional arrays of optical fibers that allow precise alignment and coupling between multiple fibers simultaneously. They are often used to connect disk arrays to photonic integrated circuits or other high-density storage i...
