Construction and Installation FTTH construction involves aerial or underground cable installation, trenching, and careful marking of existing utilities . Fiber optic cables are spliced where necessary, and junction boxes or distribution points are installed. Equipment such as pre-fabricated components, pigtails, and FTTH boxes (rated IP65 for outdoor use) are used to ensure reliable connections . Proper installation techniques and quality control are essential to minimize maintenance costs and ensure long-term network performance .
