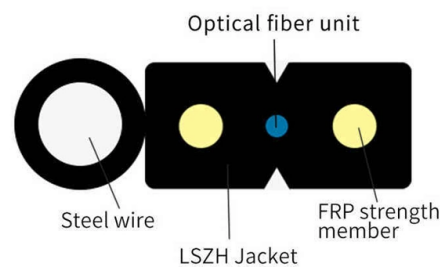

Based on Connector Type:

- Standard Adapters:** Connect identical connectors (e.g., LC-LC, SC-SC, FC-FC) for straightforward patching.
- Hybrid Adapters:** Connect different connector types (e.g., LC-SC, SC-FC), enabling compatibility across diverse systems.
- Bare Fiber Adapters:** Facilitate temporary connections for testing or emergency repairs.

Based on Fiber Mode:

- Single-Mode (SMF) Adapters:** High-precision alignment for long-distance or telecom applications.
- Multimode (MMF) Adapters:** Lower precision, suitable for local area networks and short-distance links.

Based on Port Count:

- Simplex:** Single fiber connection, typically for one-way transmission.
- Duplex:** Two fibers (TX/RX) for bidirectional communication, common in data centers.
- Quad or MPO/MTP Adapters:** Support multiple fibers for high-density environments.
