Tools and Accessories

Essential tools for drop cable splicing include:

- Precision cleaver for sub-1° cleave angles.
- Fiber strippers for both primary coating and outer jacket.
- 99% isopropyl alcohol and lint-free wipes for cleaning.
- Heat-shrink splice protection sleeves (typically 40mm for drop cables).
- Splicing tray or closure for strain relief and bend radius management.
- Safety glasses for laser protection if the network is live.

Step-by-Step Procedure

Prepare the cable: Strip the outer jacket and separate the fiber from the strength member.

Clean and cleave: Remove the primary coating to expose ~35-40mm of bare glass, clean with IPA, and cleave precisely.

Splice: Load fibers into the splicer and run the fusion cycle.

Protect: Apply a heat-shrink sleeve to safeguard the splice.

Verify: Check splice loss using a power meter or visual fault locator if available.
