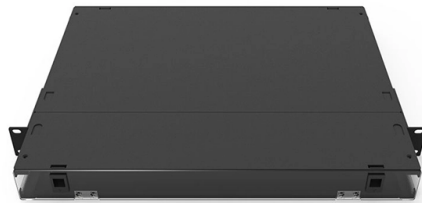

While there is no strict minimum height, installers often place the bottom of the panel 18 to 24 inches (0.45 to 0.6 meters) above the floor to avoid kneeling and to protect the box from moisture. Additional Considerations Outdoor boxes should be mounted at least 3 feet (0.9 meters) above the ground to prevent water damage. Ground-mounted boxes should be raised 2 to 4 inches (5–10 cm) to avoid moisture exposure. Clearance and working space: Maintain at least 36 inches (3 feet) in front of the panel and 30 inches wide for safe operation and maintenance. Avoid wet areas: Do not install in bathrooms, closets, or near sump pumps. Airflow and accessibility: Leave sufficient space around the box for ventilation and future inspections.
