

How to arrange power strips in a network server rack

Power strips (PDUs) should be mounted vertically along the rack sides or horizontally near the top or bottom, ensuring accessibility, proper cable management, and even power distribution. Mounting Orientation and Placement

Vertical Mounting: Attach PDUs along the side rails of the rack, either on the left or right. This maximizes outlet availability without consuming "U" space and allows for neat vertical cable routing.

Bottom placement is also acceptable, especially for heavy equipment, to simplify cable routing and reduce strain on connectors.

Accessibility and Safety: Ensure the PDU is easily accessible for plugging and unplugging devices without obstruction. Mount securely using the included brackets and screws to prevent movement or accidental disconnections. Avoid exposed locations where the PDU could be damaged or interfere with maintenance.

Cable Management: Use vertical organizers to route power cables along the rack sides, keeping them separate from data cables to reduce interference and wear. Leave enough slack in cables to prevent strain on connectors and avoid tangling. Secure cables with ties or Velcro straps to maintain a clean and organized setup, which also improves airflow and cooling efficiency.

Power Distribution and Load Balancing: Distribute devices evenly across all outlets to prevent overloading circuits and ensure stable power delivery. For larger setups, consider rack-mounted or smart PDUs with monitoring capabilities to track energy usage and...
