- Wire the Phases:** Connect L1, L2, and L3 to the MCCB, then distribute to individual MCBs for each circuit.
- Connect Neutral and Earth:** Use separate links for each phase to ensure proper grounding and neutral distribution.
- Install MCBs and RCCBs:** Mount and connect all protective devices according to the load requirements.
- Check Connections:** Ensure all terminals are tight, no exposed wires, and verify with a voltage tester before powering on.
- Label Circuits:** Clearly mark each MCB for easy identification and main...
