

How to connect fiber optic cables to a ring network switch

- LC Connectors:** Most modern SFP modules use LC-style connectors, which are compact and reliable. Ensure the fiber strands are connected in reverse between switches (A to B, B to A) to match transmit and receive ports.

Step-by-Step Connection

- Install SFP Modules:** Insert the appropriate SFP transceivers into the fiber ports of each switch.
- Prepare Fiber Cables:** Use pre-terminated duplex fiber cables with LC connectors. If field termination is required, ensure proper polishing and testing.
- Connect Switches:** Link each switch to its two neighbors in the ring. For example, Switch A connects to Switch B and Switch C, Switch B connects to Switch A and Switch D, and so on, forming a closed loop.
- Verify Polarity:** Ensure transmit (TX) and receive (RX) ports are correctly aligned between...
