

How to connect fiber optic multimode cables

Avoid bending the fiber sharply or applying excessive force, as this can degrade signal quality.

Step 4: Connect the Ethernet Side (if using a media converter) Plug an Ethernet cable into the RJ45 port of the media converter. Connect the other end to your network device (switch, router, or PC). Use Cat6 or higher cables for Gigabit connections to ensure optimal performance.

Step 5: Power and Test the Connection Connect the media converter to a stable power source or use PoE if supported. Check indicator lights for power, link status, and activity to confirm the connection is active. Optionally, configure network settings such as duplex mode, data rate, or VLANs if your converter supports management features.
