 - Splitter Box:** Includes splice trays and sometimes fiber splitter disks; designed to split and distribute optical signals efficiently.
 - Terminal Box:** Contains splice trays and pigtails for final fiber termination; minimal internal components compared to ODFs or splitter boxes.
