

How to disassemble the fiber optic router base

Remove Rubber Pads and Screws Flip the router over and remove any rubber feet or pads covering screws. Use the appropriate screwdriver to remove screws, often Torx T10 or T7, depending on the model.

Separate the Base Plate After screws are removed, gently pull the bottom plate upwards. The mainboard may still be connected to antenna wires or ribbon cables, so avoid forcing it out.

Disconnect Internal Wires Lift tape securing antenna and fan wires using tweezers. Carefully detach antenna snap connectors from the mainboard. Remove wires threaded through board "teeth" to free them. For ribbon cables, use a thin spudger or fingernail to flip the small black clip and release the cable without forcing it.

Handle the Mainboard and Components Once all wires and cables are disconnected, the mainboard can be lifted out. Take care not to bend or damage any components. Label or photograph connections to ensure correct reassembly.

Safety Tips Avoid using metal tools directly on circuit boards to prevent short circuits. Work on a static-free surface and consider using an anti-static...
