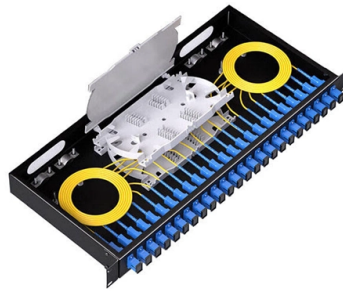


How to install trapezoidal cable tray cover plates
