

How to lay cables in a horizontal cable tray

Cables in horizontal trays should be laid neatly, spaced according to standards, supported at regular intervals, and installed without exceeding tray capacity to ensure safety and longevity.

Expansion joints must be provided at building expansion points and long outdoor runs, with bonding jumpers installed to maintain electrical continuity. Ground cable trays at least every 15 meters and at both ends.

- Organized Placement:** Lay cables in an orderly manner, avoiding excessive bending or twisting, which can damage insulation.
- Spacing:** Maintain proper separation between cables to reduce heat buildup. For multicore cables, surfaces should be separated by at least 50–75 mm depending on the group size.
- Securing Cables:** Fix cables at regular intervals using ties or clamps, ensuring they remain stable and do not sag.
- Pulling Methods:** Use the conductor for pulling medium voltage cables, not the insulation or jacket, and employ tension meters to monitor pulling forces.
- Identification:** Mark cables clearly for maintenance purposes, using labels or markers at designated intervals.
