

How to splice a router without a fiber optic box

Using Mobile Hotspots or Wireless Broadband As an alternative, you can use a mobile hotspot or wireless broadband service to provide internet to your router. Some routers support WAN connections via USB or cellular modems, allowing you to bypass traditional fiber or coax infrastructure entirely. Tips for a Stable Setup Ensure your router firmware is up to date for compatibility with bridging or alternative WAN connections. Use Ethernet connections where possible for higher stability and speed. If using wireless bridging, place the secondary router within strong signal range of the primary route...
