- Sealing:** All cable inlets and cover joints should be properly sealed to prevent dust or moisture ingress.

- Grounding:** The metal enclosure, electrical board, and appliance casings must be properly grounded.
- Protective Devices:** Each circuit should have circuit breakers, fuses, RCDs, and surge protectors as required.
- Compliance:** Follow NEC, IEC, BS 7671, or local VDE standards depending on location.
