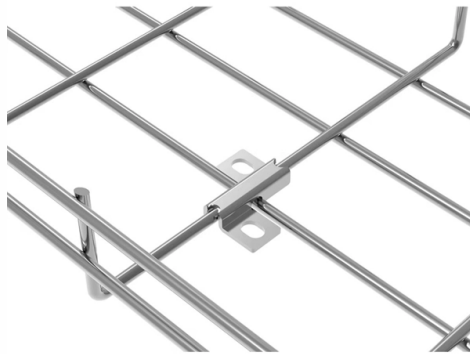


Internal structure of FCAPC connector

- 3. Epoxy Injection Tube:** The fiber is secured inside the ferrule using epoxy, which is injected through a dedicated cavity. This design prevents improper epoxy application and ensures consistent manufacturing quality.
- 4. Protective Housing and Strain Relief:** The ferrule and fiber are enclosed in a metal or plastic housing that provides mechanical protection. A strain relief boot is included to prevent fiber damage from bending or pulling, enhancing durability in field applications.
- 5. Coupling Nut and Keyway:** The connector features a threaded coupling nut for secure attachment to mating devices. A keyway ensures correct orientation, preventing mis-mating with FC/PC connectors and maintaining the angled contact necessary for low back-reflection.

Additional Features

- AR Coating:** Some FC/APC connectors used in collimation packages include anti-reflection coatings on the fiber end or lens to further reduce reflections.
- Integration with Collimators:** In fiber collimation packages, the FC/APC connector is pre-aligned to a GRIN or aspheric lens, providing diffraction-limited collimated output without movable parts.
- Environmental Protection:** The assembly is designed to withstand temperature variations and mechanical stress, though standard connectors are not vacuum compatible unless specified.
