Structure and Components An optical cable consists of a core made of glass or plastic that carries light signals, surrounded by cladding with a lower refractive index to keep light confined via total internal reflection. Protective coatings and an outer jacket shield the fibers from mechanical damage, environmental conditions, and bending stress, ensuring consistent optical performance and durability. Types of Optical Cables Single-mode (SM) fibers: Feature a narrow core ($\sim 9 \mu\text{m}$) for long-distance transmission, often tens to hundreds of kilometers, with minimal signal loss. Commonly used in backbone networks and long-haul communications. Multimode (MM) fibers: Have a wider core ($50\text{--}62.5 \mu\text{m}$) suitable for shorter distances, up to 2 km, often used in buildings, campuses, and data centers. Self-supporting cables: Reinforced with tensile elements for aerial installation without additional support structures, ideal for urban telecom networks. Armoured cables: Include metallic shielding for protection against mechanical damage and harsh environments, suitable for underground, outdoor, and industrial installations.
