

PoE switch connected to master switch

A PoE switch can be connected to a master or standard network switch using a standard Ethernet cable, allowing both data and power delivery to PoE-enabled devices while maintaining network connectivity.

Basic Connection Steps

Identify the Uplink Port: Use a standard Ethernet port on the PoE switch to connect to the master switch. This port acts as the uplink for data transmission.

PoE Standards: Verify that the switch supports the required PoE standard (IEEE 802.3af, 802.3at, or 802.3bt) for your devices.

Non-PoE Devices: If non-PoE devices are connected, the switch will transmit data only and will not supply power, preventing damage to the devices.

Network Configuration: For advanced setups, you may configure VLANs, QoS, or port-specific power allocations via the PoE switch's management interface.

Centralized Data Management: All devices connected to the PoE switch can communicate with the broader network through the master switch.
