- Single-mode modules:** Suitable for long distances (kilometers), typically using 1310 nm or 1550 nm wavelength and OS2 fiber.

Connection Considerations Ensure send and receive signals are correctly aligned between switches (A to B, B to A) when using duplex fiber. If a switch lacks SFP ports, a media converter can convert electrical signals from RJ45 ports to optical signals. Always verify brand compatibility between the switch and the transceiver module to ensure recognition and proper operation. Use clean, dust-free connectors to maintain signal quality. By selecting the correct port type, transceiver module, and fiber type, you can successfully connect a switch to a fiber optic network for reliable high-speed communication.
