Climate control systems, such as ClimaSys thermal protection, help maintain optimal temperature and humidity inside the enclosure, extending the lifespan of electronic components. Explosion and Hazardous Area Protection For installations in hazardous zones, ATEX and IECEx certified enclosures are used. These include Ex d (flameproof) and Ex tb (dust protection by enclosure) terminal and junction boxes, suitable for Zones 1, 2, 21, and 22. Such enclosures are designed to withstand high temperatures, explosive gases, and dust, and are often made from corrosion-resistant aluminum or stainless steel.
