

Protection of live parts of circuit breakers in distribution boxes



Overview

An electrical panel cover, often called a “dead front,” is the metal barrier that fits over the circuit breakers inside the main electrical box. 1 Conditions (a), (b), and (c) are as follows: (a) Exposed live parts on one side and no live or grounded parts on the other side of the working space, or exposed live parts on both sides effectively guarded by insulating material.
