

Quality Requirements for Distribution Box Bidding



AI Overview

Distribution box bids must meet strict material, installation, electrical, and compliance standards to ensure safety, durability, and regulatory approval.

Material and Structural Requirements Distribution boxes should be fabricated from 2 mm galvanized steel sheets with sufficient reinforcement to maintain structural integrity under operational conditions (). Doors must have secure locking systems (e.g., Godrej Type 3 Position Locking System) and hinges should be concealed to prevent tampering (). Roofs should be slightly slanted with a 50 mm overhang to prevent water ingress, and boxes must include solid earthing points on both sides (). Non-combustible materials are required, especially for hazardous environments ().

Installation Standards

Height and Accessibility: Floor-mounted boxes should be 50–100 mm above ground, with operating handles at 1.2–1.5 m height, and a clear space of 0.8–1.2 m in front for safe operation ().

Level and Stability: Vertical deviation must not exceed 1.5 mm for boxes under 50 cm and 3 mm for taller boxes ().

Cable Entry: Holes must be smooth, burr-free, and fitted with insulating bushings; conduit connections should be tight and secure ().

Wire Arrangement: Electrical components, switches, and lines must be orderly, firmly installed, and dust- and water-free ().

Electrical and Safety Requirements

Short-Circuit Withstand: Transformers and busbars must withstand 1.1 times the thermal stability current and 1.05 times the peak short-circuit current ().

Protection: No bare electrified parts should be exposed; external components require screen protection ().

IP Rating: Minimum IP55 for outdoor boxes; global standards may require IP54 indoors/IP65 outdoors ().

Busbar and MCCB Arrangement: Adequate clearance from the box body, with provisions for one busbar with 4-pole MCCB and outgoing feeders ().
