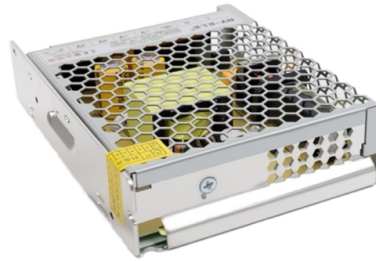


Reasons for the attack on the fiber optic cable line

Authorities say a rise in copper prices has led to an increase in attacks on communication networks.
