

Requirements for Cable Tray Wall Thickness

- Perforated (Trough) Trays:** Provide continuous bottom support with ventilation. Material thickness usually ranges from 1.0 mm to 2.0 mm for steel, with thicker walls for higher duty classes or longer spans.
- Channel Trays:** Compact trays for light-duty applications. Wall thickness is generally 0.8 mm to 1.5 mm, sufficient for small cable quantities and short runs.
- Wire Mesh (Basket) Trays:** Load capacity depends on wire diameter rather than wall thickness. Typical wire diameters range from 3 mm to 6 mm, with spacing and support intervals affecting overall strength.

Material Considerations

- Steel:** Pre-galvanized or hot-dip galvanized steel is common. Thickness is selected based on mechanical load and corrosion protection requirements.
- Stainless Steel (AISI 304/316L):** Offers corrosion resistance; wall thickness may be slightly reduced due to higher material strength.
- Aluminum:** Lightweight and corrosion-resistant; thickness is optimized for load while minimizing weight, typically slightly thinner than steel for equivalent strength.
