

Rwanda s Large-Span Bridge



Overview

Rusumo Bridge is an international bridge across the Kagera River linking Rwanda and Tanzania. Designed by Luigi Corradi and assembled previously in Turin, Italy. Fika (B2P) and the Government of Rwanda unveiled the 100th trailbridge built in Gatware sector, Nyamagabe district, Southern province, which will serve more than 3,400 people in the communities of Bimba, Kagusa, Ruhanga, Rwangambibi, Rucunda and. Rubira Bridge in Rwanda is the first masonry bridge built under the auspices of Bridges to Prosperity (B2P). 120 masonry bridges were built there with support of Belgian. This year, three teams of 30 dedicated WSP volunteers are continuing our longstanding partnership with Bridges to Prosperity, building trail bridges in some of Rwanda's most isolated regions. The project, named the Ngayake Trail.
