Secondary distribution boxes, also known as sub-distribution boxes, generally serve specific power supply areas. These boxes have inner and outer doors, powder-coated exteriors, and are designed for safety and aesthetic appeal, with rainproof tops for outdoor work. The outgoing line from the low-voltage end of the transformer is 0.4 kV to the distribution cabinet (primary distribution cabinet), then the outgoing line is led to the distribution box (secondary distribution box) in each building, and finally the outgoing line is led to the distribution cabinet.
