

# Spacing of horizontal supports for cable trays

Considerations for Support Placement Corners and bends: Install one support on each side of the bend, arranged symmetrically, to prevent stress on cables and maintain tray stability (Apex Tray). Fixed supports: Place at the beginning and end of the tray, at corners, T-junctions, and for spans exceeding 30 meters to distribute weight and prevent sagging (Apex Tray). Hanging rod supports: Use rods with a minimum diameter of 8 mm, and spacing between hangers should not exceed 1.5 meters, though this may vary with tray type and load (Apex Tray). Manufacturer guidance: Always consult the tray manufacturer's load chart to determine the exact support spacing, as it accounts for cable weight, tray material, and environmental conditions (Electrical Trader). Additional Guidelines Cable securing: Cables should be fastened at the start, end, and turns, and every 3 to 5 meters along straight horizontal runs to maintain organization and prevent mechanical strain (Apex Tray). EMI considerations: Maintain horizontal separation between power and signal trays, typically 0.5 meters, or less if trays are shielded, to reduce electromagnetic interference (Apex Tray).
