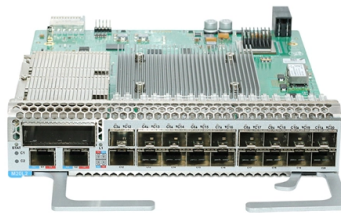

In such cases, the building department may require a small panel to provide overcurrent protection for the room's circuits. For typical rooms without permanent cooking provisions, a single panel serving multiple rooms is sufficient. Practical Design Considerations Circuit Count: A small 12-circuit panel can cover lighting, general outlets, and a few dedicated appliance circuits for a room with a kitchenette . For standard rooms (~500 sq ft), 6-8 circuits are often adequate. Accessibility: Panels must be readily accessible for maintenance and emergency shutoff . Load Management: Rooms with high-tech amenities (USB outlets, smart lighting, HVAC, minibars) may require additional circuits but not necessarily a separate distribution box per room . Modular Systems: Modern hotels may use plug-in or modular electrical systems to simplify installation and maintenance, reducing the need for multiple distribution boxes .
