- 1. Hot-Dip Galvanization (HDG)** Involves immersing steel trays in molten zinc to form a robust zinc-iron alloy coating. Provides long-term corrosion protection, ideal for outdoor or humid environments. Offers a sacrificial barrier where zinc oxidizes before steel, preventing rust formation.
- 2. Electro-Galvanization** Uses electrolysis to deposit a thin zinc layer on the tray surface. Less corrosion-resistant than hot-dip galvanization but suitable for indoor or less aggressive environments.
- 3. Powder Coating** Electrostatic powder is applied and cured at high temperature to form a protective layer. Enhances both aesthetics and corrosion resistance, commonly used in commercial or visible installations.
- 4. Oxidation Treatment (Aluminum Trays)** Forms a dense oxide film on aluminum surfaces through an electrochemical reaction. Improves corrosion resistance, surface hardness, and appearance.
- 5. Advanced Coatings**
 - Nano-coating:** Ultra-thin, high-performance layer for modern electrical systems.
 - Composite encapsulation:** Combines fiberglass-reinforced plastic (FRP) with metal for extreme durability and corrosion resistance, suitable for harsh or marine environments.
