Turn off the router and disconnect the power cord. Locate the optical network (PON) port on your router. Fiber internet transmits data using light signals through fiber-optic cables, which differs from traditional DSL or cable internet. Instead of a modem, fiber connections require an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), a device that converts fiber signals into an Ethernet connection. Compatible router: Verify that your router supports fiber optic input (look for an SFP or WAN port labeled). The process to connect fiber optic cable to router requires careful attention to detail, but I'll walk you through every critical step with the precision and clarity you deserve.
