Label each cable: Clearly mark each cable to indicate its destination or function. This simplifies troubleshooting and maintenance. Wiring Techniques If you are connecting multiple cables to a single point (like a switch or outlet): Avoid direct splicing: Do not twist multiple Ethernet cables together without proper connectors, as this can degrade signal quality. Use patch cables: Connect each terminated cable from the distribution box to the switch using short patch cables. This ensures stable connections and reduces wear on the main cables. Maintain proper bend radius: Avoid sharp bends to prevent signal loss or damage to the cable conductors. Safety and Performance Tips Ensure the distribution box is dry, ventilated, and accessible. Use full copper cables rather than CCA (Copper Clad Aluminum) to maintain low resistance and pre...
