To sell or distribute 3C distribution boxes in the UAE, manufacturers or importers must obtain an ECAS Certificate of Conformity confirming compliance with UAE technical and safety standards.

Overview of ECAS Certification

The Emirates Conformity Assessment Scheme (ECAS) is the mandatory certification route for regulated products, including electrical distribution boxes, to ensure they meet approved safety, quality, and performance standards before entering the UAE market. Without ECAS certification, products may be blocked at customs or removed during market inspections.

Key Steps in the Certification Process

Product Classification and Scope Determination Identify whether the 3C distribution box falls under ECAS-regulated categories. Correct classification is critical, as misclassification is a common cause of delays.

Technical Documentation Submission Prepare and submit technical documents, including product specifications, drawings, test reports, and compliance with relevant standards such as IEC 60364 and UAE Electricity Wiring Regulations.

Testing and Evaluation Conduct product testing in accredited laboratories to verify compliance with UAE standards. This may include electrical safety, insulation, and earth fault loop impedance tests.

Technical Assessment of Manufacturer or Importer A technical assessor may visit the manufacturing facility or importer's site to evaluate production processes and quality control systems. Fees are typically 2,500 AED per working day per assessor.

Issuance of Certificate of Conformity (CoC) Upon successful evaluation and testing, the Ministry of Industry and Advanced Technology issues the CoC, confirming the product meets UAE technical requirements.
