

What are the methods for outdoor fiber optic cable installation

Clear ducts and pre-install pulling ropes with silicone grease to reduce friction. For aerial installation: Survey pole spans and install hoop steel bands and suspension fittings. Maintain a 0.5% sag to prevent wind-induced swinging.
- 4. Cable Pulling** Use a tension controller to monitor pulling force and avoid exceeding the cable's rated tensile strength. Keep pulling speed ≤ 15 m/min. Use swivel connectors and guiding pulleys at corners to prevent torque and bending. Avoid sharp bends and maintain the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer.
- 5. Splicing and Termination** Perform splicing inside a splice closure with humidity below 70%. Clean fibers with alcohol wipes and lint-free paper. Match fusion splicer parameters to the fiber type and protect splices with heat-shrink sleeves. Ensure proper alignment and secure placement in the clamp plate.
