5. Connectors and Adapter Plates The front panel of the ODB typically contains connectors for transmitting signals. Adapter plates allow easy connection between pigtailed and external fiber cables, supporting both single-mode and multi-mode fibers .

6. Optional Components Some ODBs may include splitters for Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) networks, inline splice sleeves for long-distance cable runs, or specialized closures for aerial, buried, or wall-mounted installations .
