Step 4: Installation Height and Position Install the box at a convenient height, typically 1.5-1.8 meters above the ground for easy access and inspection. Ensure the box is mounted firmly, horizontally, and vertically, with minimal deviation, using appropriate brackets or screws. Leave sufficient space around the box for wiring and ventilation.
